## Overview

## Student Responsibilities

1. Students are expected to use school devices for educational purposes.
2. Students may not install software, download apps, games, videos or attempt to reconfigure the software of a device,
3. Students are encouraged to store documents and other files under their school managed Google Drive.
4. Students are required to login to a device using their school provided login.
5. When taking video and/or photoes, students should get the subject of the video/photos permission.

## Parent Expectations

1. The district asks for the parents' support in communicating with their children about the standards appropriate content.
2. Parents are responsible for signing the Parent/Student Agreement form.

## Terms of the Chromebook Loan

1. Software and apps will be managed by the district, due to the need to comply with licensing agreements.
2. Devices are subject to routine monitoring by teachers, administrators and/or technology staff. Users have no expectation of privacy when using Medora Community Schools equipment or technology systems.
3. Each device has identifying labels, which must not be removed or altered in any fashion.
